

Trellis & Vine Shawl
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Yarn: Brown Sheep Cotton Fleece (80% Cotton/20% Merino Wool, 215 yds / 197m per 100g skein): 3 skeins #220 Provincial Rose

Yarn Substitutions: Any dk or light worsted weight yarn

Needles: US 6 (4 mm) straight needles

Supplies: Stitch markers, tapestry needle

Gauge: 20sts-24 rows per 4 inch(10cm) in stockinette stitch

Finished Measurements:
14.5 inches x 80 inches (37cm x 203cm)

Skill Level: Intermediate



Stitch Instructions:

sk2p – sl 1, k2tog, pss0

2-st right purl twist - sl 1 st to cn and hold to back, k1, p1 from cn.

2-st left purl twist - sl 1 st to cn and hold to front, pl, k1 from cn.

small bobble – (p1,k1) 2 times into the next st, slip 2nd, 3rd, 4th st over 1st st

Only right side rows appear on chart.

Side Panel Pattern

Work 8 rows in rev. st-st.

Work entirety of Chart 1 twice.

Work Chart 1A once.

Work 12 rows in rev. st-st.

Work Chart 1A once.

Work Chart 1B 4 times.

Work Chart 1C once.

Work 12 rows in rev. st-st.

Work Chart 1C once.

Work entirety of Chart 1 twice.

Work 8 rows in rev. st-st.

Pattern

Cast on 76 sts.

Knit 2 rows.

Next RS row work as follows: K4, start side panel pattern (16sts), k1, yo, sk2p, yo, k1, p2, k2, p2, k1, yo, sk2p, yo, k1, start side panel pattern (16 sts), k4.

Next WS and all WS rows as follows: k2, continue working stitches as they lay (if k on

RS, then p on WS OR if p or RS then k on WS), purling yarn-overs, to last 2 sts, k2.

Continue to work in this manner until the side panel pattern is completed. Then knit 2 rows and cast-off.
